WHEREAS, the parties to this Order and Court intend this Order to be a Qualified Domestic Relations Order (hereinafter referred to as "Order" or "QDRO") as that term is used in the Retirement Equity Act of 1984, as amended, and interpreted in accordance with that Act; and

WHEREAS, the parties have stipulated that the Court shall enter this Order as an Addendum to the Decree of Dissolution of Marriage filed herein on [date filed with court] , NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Court as follows:

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1. Definitions . The following are the definitions used in this Order:

13 2. Division of Marital Property. This Order is entered into
14 pursuant to RCW 26.09.080 governing division of marital property (as
15 that term is defined therein) between spouses and former spouses in
16 divorce actions. This Order hereby creates and recognizes the
17 existence of the Alternate Payee's rights to receive a portion of
18 the Participant's benefits under the Plan.

19 3. Participant's Retirement. Participant retired effective
20 [date] and is receiving benefits in the form of [form of
21 payment].

22 4. Payments to Alternate Payee.

23 4.1 Effective with benefits payable for [month/year], the
24 Alternate Payee is awarded [what percent or dollar amount] of each
25 of the Participant's monthly benefit payments from the Plan.
Alternate Payee [is/is not] entitled to share in "thirteenth"
benefit checks. Alternate Payee's benefits shall be paid directly

26 4.2 [FOR USE IF THE PARTICIPANT IS RECEIVING THE SINGLE LIFE
27 BENEFIT.] The Alternate Payee's benefits will cease at the earliest
28 of the Participant's death or the Alternate Payee's death, provided
29 that if the Participant dies prior to payment of the guaranteed
30 monthly payments, Alternate Payee's benefits will cease at the
31 earlier of payment of the guaranteed monthly payments, or Alterna-
32 tive Payee's death. If the Alternate Payee predeceases the
33 Participant, the Alternate Payee's share shall revert to the
34 Participant.

35 4.2 [FOR USE IF THE PARTICIPANT IS RECEIVING THE JOINT AND
SURVIVOR BENEFIT.] The Alternate Payee's benefits cease at the
earliest of the Participant's death or the Alternate Payee's death,

1 provided that if the Participant predeceases the Alternate Payee,
2 the Alternate Payee shall be the Participant's sole surviving spouse
3 entitled to receive the survivor benefit following the Participant's
4 death. If the Alternate Payee predeceases the Participant, the
5 Alternate Payee's share shall revert to the Participant.

6 4.3 In the event the Participant returns to work after
7 retirement, the Participant's benefits may be suspended. In such
8 event, the Alternate Payee's benefits shall also be suspended.

9 **5. Limitations on Order.** Nothing contained in this Order
10 shall be construed to require the Plan:

11 5.1 To provide for any type or form of benefits, or any
12 option, not otherwise provided under the Plan at the time benefits
13 commence to the Alternate Payee;

14 5.2 To provide increased benefits (determined on the basis of
15 actuarial value) not available to the Participant;

16 5.3 To provide benefits to the Alternate Payee which are
17 required to be paid to another Alternate Payee under another order
18 previously determined to be a QDRO; and

19 5.4 To provide the payment to the Alternate Payee of benefits
20 forfeited by the Participant.

21 **6. Action to Be Taken.** The Plan Administrator shall be
22 provided with a copy of the Order by the Alternate Payee or
23 Participant. Pending determination of a proposed order's status as
24 a QDRO, the Plan Administrator shall separately account within the
25 Plan for the amount ("segregated amounts") which would have been
payable to the Alternate Payee (if this Order is established to be
a QDRO) during the determination period, as defined in Internal
Revenue Code Section 414(p)(7). No segregation is necessary if
benefits are not payable during the determination period.

7. **Continuing Jurisdiction.** The Court retains jurisdiction
over this matter to amend this order to establish or maintain its
status as a QDRO under the Retirement Equity Act of 1984, as
amended.
