When can we help?

When you call, you can expect the following: We will help you assess the problem and work with you to establish a plan of action. Once we have identified the problem, if needed, we will refer you to qualified community resources and follow up with you to make sure the referral is effective.

How is my privacy maintained?

Your participation in the Employee Assistance Program is strictly confidential, unless you disclose that you are a risk to yourself or someone else.

The majority of employees contact the program on their own. However, if your supervisor refers you due to job performance problems, he or she is told only that you have undertaken an approved plan of action. Any information about your personal situation will only be disclosed with your written consent.

How much does it cost?

Employee Assistance Program services are available to all employees and their families at no cost. Rates and fees for treatment services and other outside resources, as well as benefit coverage, will be discussed with you when you contact a program professional. We make every effort to ensure that the services we recommend are not only professional, but convenient and affordable.

Where do I begin?

A sense of isolation is often the biggest barrier to solving problems. Asking for help is the first step and sometimes the most important part of resolving an important issue in your life. We're here to help you.
